




- a. Save souls from eternal condamnation


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Eschatological Salvation

Physical, Creational Salvation




Definition of Evangelism according to David Bosch

DEFINITION	THEOLOGICAL ASPECTS
Evangelisation can be defined as the dimension and activity of the church which offers	Being and Doing of the Church!
to every human being everywhere	individual - universal
by word and by deed	holistically
a real opportunity,	intentionally
to be challenged to a <u>radical reorientation</u> in the sense of the Gospel	Proprium: existential conversion

Definition of Evangelisation according to David Bosch

Content of reorientation:	In view to man:
• to commit one's life to Jesus as Saviour and Lord,	change of power
to become member of the local church as part of the body of Christ	ecclesiologically
 to be delivered of the destroying bonds (human and supra-human, individual and social) (Bosch: liberation of the slavery of the world and its powers) 	soteriologically contextually
to be involved into the ministry of Christ of reconciliation, peace and justice on earth	contextual sending
integrated into the plan of God to put all things under the rule of Christ.	eschatological perspective
